
Energy Vocab


- 1.) Nonrenewable: a natural resource that is NOT replaced after it's been used.
- 2.) Renewable: a resource that's naturally replaced in a short time.
- 3.) Energy: The ability to cause, change, or do work.
- $4.) \ \mbox{Mechanical Energy:} \ \mbox{Energy of an object due to its position, motion, or both.}$
- 5.) Electrical Energy: Energy of electrical charges as a result of their position or motion.
- 6.) Gravatational Potential Energy: Energy gained by an object as it's height above ground level increases.

- 7.) Chemical Energy: Energy stored in the chemical bonds of molecules.
- 8.) Nuclear Energy: Energy that is released by either splitting atomic nuclei or by forcing the nuclei of atoms together.
- 9.) Radiant Energy: Energy in the form of electromagnetic waves (ex. light energy).
- 10.) Thermal Energy: Energy due to the vibration of molecules (ex. heat energy).
- 11.) Acoustic Energy: Energy that you can hear (ex. sound energy).
- 12.) Energy Transformation: \boldsymbol{A} change in energy from one form to another.









